Advisory Board Members commitment and engagement opportunities

- Attend one virtual meeting per year with the Board of Directors
- Read monthly updates from the Director
- Most advisory board members contribute \$300 to fund a year of a child's education
- Assist with one fundraising effort during the year, such as 'donating' their birthday, Giving Tuesday, or our September sponsor a child's education campaign
- Advisory Board Members are welcome to serve on a Board committee such as development/fundraising; strategic planning; or communications.
- Some advisory members assist with occasional projects, such as editing of communication materials.

Appointment and terms:

- Advisory Board members can self-nominate or be nominated by other board members.
- They are appointed through majority vote of the current Board of Directors.
- Advisor Board members serve two-year terms which are renewable.

Fundraising, donations, and advocacy:

- We encourage Advisory Board members to donate \$300 per year.
- Many members support fundraising in other ways, which may include:
 - Identifying potential sources of funding or community growth by recommending our work to potentially interested individuals, community groups, faith communities, businesses, foundations, etc.
 - Conducting one social media crowdfunding effort annually. A guide to crowdfunding is provided. Some prefer to 'donate' their birthday.
 - Sharing our organization and its work with others who may be interested.
